KEY DEPOSIT - FOR RESIDENTIAL CAMPERS ONLY

At registration the following **CASH** room key deposits are required of all residential campers. This is a University policy with **no exception**. Yes CASH at all locations.

CLOTHES AND OTHER ARTICLES

Campers may use the washers & dryers at camp. All articles should be plainly labeled. Use your discretion as to quantities:

Suitcase or trunk with lock and key, blanket or sleeping bag, sheets, pillow, pillow case, towels, laundry bag, bathing suits, pool footwear, thongs, coat hangers, soap, comb, toothbrush/paste, shampoo, tissues, fan (optional), stationery, postcards, stamps, pens, pencils, **3-ring loose-leaf binder, USB memory stick on a lanyard**, rain coat, hat, waist pouch (optional), \$10-20 per week spending money (mostly singles and 25 cent coins), informal clothing - jeans, shorts, T-shirts, sneakers, etc. Favorite games & books - optional (chess, checkers), tennis racket and balls - if you plan to play and magic cards - if you play.

All campers' **medications** must be brought to camp properly labeled and in the original containers. Be sure to also include detailed instructions.

**Connecticut campers who wish to play tennis need to bring sneakers that leave NO scuff marks.
